Q: How do I submit my work?

Q: How would I submit a painting? Dance? Poem?

A: Using our [Submission Form](#), please submit a digital version of your piece. Good quality, high resolution photos of art, videos, and audio files can also be submitted through this site.

Q: Can I work on this with a group?

A: Yes! Absolutely. Any number of friends or classmates are welcome to come together to work on a project to submit. It will be counted as one entry though and would only be eligible for one award.

Q: How many prizes are there?

A: Two

Q: What is Sarah's Inn's policy on plagiarism?

A: Sarah's Inn and the Youth Voice Award judges have a zero tolerance policy on plagiarism. Any words, music, or art that are not original to you cannot be passed off as your own.
